



## Helping Families Grow Through Statutory Intervention Webinar - September 29th, 2023, 17:00 E.E.T. (16:00 C.E.T.)

We invite you to a free webinar in English on Google Meet about the current legal responses to the demographic challenges of population and fertility decline in Romania and Central Europe. Romania has known a population decline and a fertility decrease since the 1990s. These demographic challenges have met several statutory responses, especially since 2010.

After presenting results from the *Demographic Challenges – Legal Responses* research project organized by the Central European Academy of Budapest and the Central European Professors' Network, the webinar will be open to free discussions about which of the current laws has a demographic improvement goal and what is their actual efficiency. Other discussion topics will be formulating suggestions for further legislation changes that could lead to stopping or at least diminishing the population decline.

The event is open to all lawyers, law professors or researchers interested in the subject of law and its demographic impact.
